MEMORANDUM FOR Rugged Battalion Troopers

SUBJECT: Rugged Policy Letter #2 (Standing CCCIR)

1. Call Rugged 6 (regardless of time of day or night) if one of the following occur:
 - a. *Death/serious injury involving Rugged troopers or family members.
 - b. *Actual or alleged incidents on non-consensual sex, rape, aggravated assault, kidnapping, suicide, or attempted suicide including suicide gestures.
 - c. *Training accident involving weapons, damage in excess of \$10,000, hospitalization, or resulted from negligence.
 - d. *Theft loss, suspected theft, unaccounted, or recovered weapons, ammunition, sensitive items.
 - e. *Injury to troopers or family members involving firearms, munitions, IEDs.
 - f. *All aircraft accidents, including UAVs
 - g. *Fire causing death, serious injury, or major damage of Rugged Area or troopers home.
 - h. *That actual or possible compromise of operational codes.
 - i. *Any on/off post incident that is related or suspected to be terrorism related.
 - j. *Misconduct motivated by race, ethnicity, gender or sexual orientation.
 - k. *Misconduct involving NCO SFC or higher, warrant or commissioned officer.
 - l. *Any incident that will result in adverse publicity to Fort Lewis, U.S. Army, or Department of Defense.
 - m. DEPOD/Alert Notification
 - n. Increase in FPCON

*CG, I Corps CCIR IAW FL Reg 210-15 and SIR IAW AR 190-40 and FORSCOM Supplement 1
2. Inform Rugged 6 as appropriate if one of the following occur:
 - a. Admission of Rugged Trooper or family member to hospital
 - b. Domestic Violence
 - c. Incarceration of a Rugged Trooper
 - d. Barracks Incident
 - e. Incident involving drugs or alcohol
 - f. Inability of Rugged Bn to meet the requirements of directed missions
 - g. COMSEC violation
 - h. Hazardous material spill of 5 gallons or more
 - i. Birth of a child
 - j. Promotion to SGT or higher
 - k. Reenlistment of Soldiers
 - l. Arrival of any 1SG, Warrant Officer, or Officer (need notified with in 24 hours of arrival).
3. Remember – bad news never improves with age. Partial reports are acceptable; provide available information and follow-up later. If in doubt call the Rugged CSM or XO.
