SUBJECT: CLARIFICATION OF AR 381-10, US ARMY INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES

- A. ELEC MSG DA WASHDC, DAMI-CIC, 231200Z MAY 86, SUBJ: AR 381-10, SUBJ: AR 381-10, US ARMY INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES.
- REF INDICATED THAT AR 381-10 WOULD SOON BE REISSUED IN THE UPDATE FORMAT. HOWEVER SOME ADMINISTRATIVE PROBLEMS HAVE DEVELOPED WHICH WILL SLOW DOWN THE REISSUE CONSIDERABLY. THESE SAME PROBLEMS PRECLUDE PUBLISHING NORMAL AND ROUTINE OFFICIAL CHANGES TO THE AR.
 - THE CURRENT VERSION OF AR 381-10, EFFECTIVE DATE 1 AUG 84, HAS NOW BEEN IN USE FOR ALMOST TWO YEARS, AND SOME SUBJECTS HAVE SURFACED REPEATEDLY WHICH DEMAND CLARIFICATION. IN LIEU OF AN ACTUAL HARD COPY CHANGE TO THE AR, THIS MESSAGE IS USED TO PASS ON CERTAIN CLARIFICATIONS. THESE CLARIFICATIONS ARE POLICY DECISIONS AND HAVE BEEN COORDINATED WITH THE DA INSPECTOR GENERAL (DAIG), THE ARMY GENERAL COUNSEL (AGC), AND THE JUDGE ADVOCATE GENERAL (TJAG).
 - PROCEDURE 9, PARA B, LINE 6: ADD THE FOLLOWING PARAGRAPH: "TRAINING EXERCISES: ARE DEFINED AS THOSE ACTIVITIES SPONSORED BY ARMY INTELLIGENCE COMPONENTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PRACTICING AND ENHANCING PHYSICAL SURVEILLANCE AND OTHER TRADECRAFT SKILLS". (PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS CLARIFICATION WAS DISSEMINATED VIA REF A, THIS ADDITION CLARIFIES THE MEANING OF INTELLIGENCE TRAINING.)
 - PROCEDURE 9: ADD THE FOLLOWING PARAGRAPH, TO BE IDENTIFIED AS SUB PARA 4D: "THIS PROCEDURE DOES NOT LIMIT OR RESTRICT TACTICAL INFORMATION COLLECTION DEEMED ESSENTIAL BY THE COMMANDER AT THE SITE OF A COUNTERTERRORIST OPERATION OVERSEAS." (THIS ADDITION WILL ENSURE THAT COUNTERTERRORIST OPERATIONS ARE NOT HINDERED BY AMBIGUITY).
 - PROCEDURE 14, PARA B3E, LINE 5: ADD THE WORD "ASSISTANCE" BETWEEN THE WORDS OVERSIGHT AND OFFICER. THE NEW TITLE THEREFORE BECOMES THE INTELLIGENCE OVERSIGHT ASSISTANCE OFFICER OF THE ACS1, HQDA. (THIS CLARIFIES THE ACTUAL ROLE OF THE ACS1 IOAO.)
 - PROCEDURE 14, PARA B3E, LINE 8: ADD THE FOLLOWING TO THE EXISTING PARAGRAPH: "SHOULD COMPARTMENTATION RESTRICTIONS (FOR EXAMPLE SPECIAL ACCESS PROGRAM PROCEDURES) PRECLUDE IMMEDIATE ACCESS TO INFORMATION BY PERSONNEL PERFORMING OVERSIGHT FUNCTIONS, THE RESPONSIBLE COMMANDER SHALL IMMEDIATELY REPORT THIS SITUATION TO THE APPROPRIATE ACCESS CONTROL AUTHORITY FOR AN ACCESS ELIGIBILITY DETERMINATION. THE INSPECTING OFFICIAL SHALL TRANSMIT A SIMULTANEOUS MESSAGE THROUGH HIS OR HER CHAIN OF COMMAND". (PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS CLARIFICATION WAS DISSEMINATED VIA REF A, AND IS INTENDED TO ENSURE THAT ALL OVERSIGHT PERSONNEL HAVE COMPLETE ACCESS IN ORDER TO DO THEIR JOB).
 - PROCEDURE 15, PARA C1A (2): ADD THE FOLLOWING NEW PARAGRAPH AS PARAGRAPH C1A (2): "WHEN AN INSPECTOR GENERAL IDENTIFIES A QUESTIONABLE ACTIVITY, HE WILL SUBMIT A REPORT SIMULTANEOUSLY THRU COMMAND CHANNELS AND TO THE OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL, HQDA, ATTN: DAIG-10, WASHINGTON, D.C. 20310-1756." (THIS ADDITION WILL CLARIFY THE ROLE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL IN THE OVERSIGHT PROCESS.)

SUBJ: OVERSIGHT OF INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES

1. REFERENCES.

A. DOD 5240.1-R, 7 DEC 82, PROCEDURES GOVERNING THE ACTIVITIES OF DOD INTELLIGENCE COMPONENTS THAT AFFECT UNITED STATES PERSONS.

B. AR 10-5, 30 NOV 92, HEADQUARTERS, DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY,

ORGANIZATION AND FUNCTIONS.

C. AR 20-1, 15 MAR 94, INSPECTOR GENERAL ACTIVITIES AND PROCEDURES.

D. AR 381-10, 1 AUG 84, US ARMY INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES.

2. UNDER DIRECTION OF THE SECRETARY OF THE ARMY, THE INSPECTOR GENERAL OF THE ARMY (TIG) PROVIDES AN INDEPENDENT OVERSIGHT OF ALL ARMY INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES IN COORDINATION WITH THE OFFICE OF THE GENERAL COUNSEL (OGC) AND IN COMPLIANCE WITH APPROPRIATE LAWS, EXECUTIVE ORDERS AND REGULATIONS. THE DEPUTY CHIEF OF STAFF FOR INTELLIGENCE (DCSINT) IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PROPRIETY OF US ARMY INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES, IN COORDINATION WITH THE OGC AND WITH LEGAL ADVICE FROM THE JUDGE ADVOCATE GENERAL (TJAG). PROCEDURE 15, AR 381-10, CURRENTLY REQUIRES ALL ARMY PERSONNEL TO REPORT QUESTIONABLE INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES THROUGH INTELLIGENCE CHANNELS TO THE DCSINT. HOWEVER, IT HAS BEEN DETERMINED THAT THIS OVERSIGHT FUNCTION HEREAFTER WILL BE PERFORMED BY TIG.

3. THE DEPUTY CHIEF OF THE STAFF FOR INTELLIGENCE (DCSINT) AND THE INSPECTOR GENERAL (TIG) OF THE ARMY RECENTLY SIGNED A MOA WHICH CHANGES PROCEDURE 15 REPORTING (AR 381-10) RESPONSIBILITIES FROM THE DCSINT TO TIG. THE MOA ALSO PROVIDES FOR THE REALIGNMENT OF ONE MILITARY INTELLIGENCE CIVILIAN EXCEPTED CAREER PROGRAM (MICECP) SPACE IN SUPPORT OF THIS FUNCTION. INSCOM WILL CHANGE THE PLACE OF DUTY FOR THE DETAILED MICECP EMPLOYEE FROM DCSINT TO TIG. THIS CHANGE IS EFFECTIVE 1 JANUARY 1995.

4. EFFECTIVE 1 JAN 95, THIS MESSAGE MODIFIES AR 381-10 PROCEDURE 15 REPORTING REQUIREMENTS AS FOLLOWS:

A. ALLEGATIONS OF QUESTIONABLE ACTIVITIES WILL NO LONGER BE REPORTED TO HQDA DCSINT (DAMI-CI). AS OF 1 JAN 95, ALL ALLEGATIONS OF QUESTIONABLE INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES WILL BE REPORTED TO TIG (SAIG-10). CONTINUE TO USE THE FORMAT PROVIDED IN AR 381-10, PROCEDURE 15 FOR THE CONTENT OF THE REPORT.

B. MACOMS WILL ALSO CHANGE THE MESSAGE ADDRESS FOR THE QUARTERLY INTELLIGENCE OVERSIGHT REPORT FROM DAMI-CIC TO SAIG-10. REPORTS CAN BE DONE IN MEMORANDUM FORMAT AND BE FAXED TO SAIG-10 AT STU 111 SECURE DSN 227-6698 OR NONSECURE 225-7600. THIS REPORT IS DUE NOT LATER THAN 15 DAYS FOLLOWING THE CLOSE OF THE QUARTER. THE 1QFY95 REPORT COVERS THE TIME PERIOD FROM 1 OCT 94 TO 31 DEC 94 AND IS TO BE RECEIVED BY TIG (SAIG-10) BY 15 JAN 95.

5. THIS MESSAGE DOES NOT CHANGE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF INTELLIGENCE
