ENVIRONMENTAL OBJECTIVES AND TARGETS (4.3.3)

The following are the current JTD environmental objectives and targets for the identified process area. The objectives and targets were developed in accordance with the Installation Sustainability Program (ISP).

AIR QUALITY/ENERGY USE

Objective: JTD will support the Installation Sustainability Program's plan to reduce the installation traffic congestion and traffic emissions by 85 percent by the year 2025.

Targets:

- Obtain and use Neighborhood Electric Vehicles (NEV), or a comparable alternate, for administrative and light cargo movement in the JTD Deployment Facility, Logistics Center, by the year 2007.
- JTD TMP continues to pursue obtaining alternate fueled vehicles from the GSA commercial fleet.
- Publicize and increase JTD employee participation in the Ride Share Program by the year 2007.

PRODUCTS AND MATERIALS USE

Objective: Reduce administrative paper usage and disposal of recyclable material.

Targets:

- Begin tracking paper usage per division in JTD.
- Establish a target for paper purchase and usage.
- Develop a system for outlining the process of recyclable materials.
